

Privacy Policy

Introduction

This website, cfnp.ca (along with all translated versions of which hereafter referred to as the “Site”) is operated by Canadians For a New Partnership (“We” or “Us”). CFNP is the operating name of the “Canadians For a New Partnership,” a non-profit organization incorporated in the Province of Ontario.

CFNP is committed to protecting your privacy online. We’re members too, and we treat your privacy as we do our own. We wrote this privacy policy to let you know how we treat your personal information – and to show you all the ways we work hard to keep it safe and private.

Please read the following carefully to understand our policies and practices regarding your personal information and how we will treat it. By using or accessing our Website, you agree to this privacy policy. This policy applies only to information collected through this website (cfnp.ca) and does not apply to information collected on any affiliated site or third-party site or by any third-party application that may link to or be accessible from this Website, nor does it apply to any offline contact between you and CFNP. This policy may change from time to time (see [Changes to the Privacy Policy](#)) and your continued use of the Website is deemed to be acceptance of such changes, so please check the policy periodically for updates.

CFNP will send you updates by e-mail. If at any time you would like to unsubscribe from our email list, you may do so by contacting unsubscribe@cfnp.ca with the subject heading “unsubscribe.”

Your Personal Information

In addition to the information you provide us, we collect certain additional information to help us improve our campaigns and to otherwise better serve our collective mission to close the gap between the world we have and the world most people everywhere want. We collect and use the following information:

- Information that you provide by filling in forms on our Website or participating online in our campaigns. This includes information provided at the time of registering as a member, signing petitions, sending messages through our site to campaign targets or others, or otherwise filling out forms on the CFNP website. We may also ask you for information when you report a problem with our Website.
- Records and copies of your correspondence (including e-mail addresses), if you contact us.
- Your responses to surveys that we might ask you to complete for research purposes or to help direct our campaigns and activities, although you do not have to respond to them.
- Details of transactions you carry out through our Website if you are one of our members who generously support CFNP financially and the work we do together.
- Certain information about usage of the CFNP site, described below in the section on [Data Tracking](#).

Where from the world you hail and whether you tell others about CFNP campaigns.

We do not share the information you’ve given us with unaffiliated groups without your explicit permission. We may share some of your personal information with certain affiliated groups. For example: Affiliated Third Parties and contractors – such as our database administrators – for the sole purpose of helping us do our work. These groups do not share your personal information or use it for any purpose other than as instructed by us.

Third Party Administrators, such as organizations we engage to facilitate large distribution of messages. The content of these emails will be from CFNP and these third parties do not have direct access to your personally identifiable information.

In addition, with your explicit permission, we pass along certain parts of your information to the following groups (as is standard practice):

- World leaders, news publications and other targets when you choose to use our email tool to send them messages.
- World leaders, news publications, and the general public when you sign petitions or complete surveys.
- Further information about how we use personal information in connection with particular types of campaigns is discussed below.

Petitions and Surveys

For petitions and surveys you've signed or completed, we treat your name, city, province or territory, and comments as public information—for example, we may provide compilations of petitions, with your comments, to leaders and other target audiences, or to the press. We will not make your street address or email publicly available, but we may transmit it to the designated target as part of a petition. This is a standard industry practice in such situations. In no such case will we disclose your email address or phone number, without your permission. We may also make your comments, along with your first and last name, city and province or territory available to the press and public online. When you do give permission for us to share your email address as part of a campaign, CFNP is not responsible for the content or use of your email address by campaign targets.

Sending Emails Via CFNP

In certain cases, we enable you to send individual e-mails to leaders or other targets as well as Letters-to-the-Editor to various news publications, through our website. These messages are sent in your name, with your e-mail address as the return address and your full name and contact information is provided as part of the submission. These messages will only be sent out under your name as you approve them on an individual basis using our email tool. You are solely responsible for the specific message(s) you send using our email tool. CFNP takes no responsibility for the content or use of your email address by campaign targets.

Financial Donations

If you choose to make a donation to CFNP, your credit card information will be used only for this transaction through our secure online payment system. CFNP does not retain credit card information.

Phone Campaigns

From time to time, the CFNP staff members or CFNP volunteers may contact you by telephone about urgent campaigns. If you have provided your telephone number to us through our website then you may be contacted by one of our volunteers or staff members (each of whom are bound by the terms of the CFNP privacy policy and will not use your personal information for any other purpose). If you would like to be removed permanently from our phone list, please email us at info@cfnp.ca with the subject line "UNSUBSCRIBE PHONE NUMBER". Please allow 8-10 business days for your information to be removed.

CFNP-Initiated Petitions and Declarations

When people sign on to support a CFNP campaign, CFNP collects the information signers provide in order to send those new participants information about future campaigns and otherwise to further the CFNP mission. CFNP may send thank you notes and other correspondence to people who participate in these campaigns.

Data Security

When you give CFNP personal information, we take steps to ensure that your information is treated securely. Unfortunately, no data transmission over the Internet can be guaranteed to be 100% secure. As a result, while we strive to protect your personal information, CFNP cannot ensure or warrant the security of any information you transmit to us, and you do so at your own risk. Once we receive your transmission, we make our best effort to ensure its security on our systems.

Children

CFNP does not solicit nor knowingly collect personally identifying information from children. Visitors who are under 13 years of age should ask their parent or legal guardian for assistance when using the Site and should not submit any personally identifying information to the Site. For example, visitors under 13 years of age should not make donations, provide their name, address, contact information, or other information, or use the CFNP email tool.

Cookies

Some parts of the Site are password-protected. We will use a cookie (cookies reside on your computer and are under the control of your browser) to enable you to return to password-protected areas of the website without having to re-enter your password or to otherwise optimize your experience on the site by, for example, tracking the type of webmail you are using to maximize the site's compatibility with your system. We also may use cookies to track data without identifying specific users as described below. If you wish to disable these cookies, the help portion of the tool bar on most browsers will tell you how to do that. If you set your browser to disable cookies, however, you may not be able to access certain parts of this Site.

Data Tracking

In order to better serve our members, in addition to collecting the information listed above, we also use cookies and other tools such as Google Analytics, Litmus and similar services to analyze web activity. These services provide us with statistical data that does not identify any individual. This helps us understand traffic patterns and know if there are problems with our website. We may also use embedded images in emails to track open rates for our mailings, so that we can tell which mailings appeal most to CFNP members. We also may collect IP addresses or other data about visits to our website to better understand where our traffic is coming from, how our services are being accessed, and to provide customized services to members.

URLs contained in emails may contain an ID that enables us to correctly identify the person who takes an action using a web page. We use these URLs to simplify the process of signing petitions and filling out surveys. We may occasionally present a shortened URL that references a longer URL which contains an

id—we do this to simplify the display, to prevent links from becoming broken when copied, and to ensure compatibility with email programs which do not handle long URLs. When a shortened URL is displayed in an email, you will see the full URL in the browser's address bar when you access the page.

Links to Other Websites

CFNP may provide links to third party web sites, and other web sites may provide links to the Site. Third party web sites operate according to their own terms of use and privacy policies. CFNP has no control over such third party web sites, and by using this Site, you acknowledge and agree that CFNP is not responsible for the availability of such third party sites, and does not endorse and is not responsible or liable for any content, advertising, products or other materials on or available from such sites. You further acknowledge and agree that CFNP will not be responsible or liable, directly or indirectly, for any damage or loss caused or alleged to be caused by or in connection with use of or reliance on any content, advertising, products, or other materials on or available from such sites.

Accessing and Correcting Your Personal Information

You can review and update your personal information by logging into the Website when option is available and visiting your account profile page and making changes. If you have forgotten your password, once you have tried to register and failed, you can click on the "Forgot your password?" link to reach a page on which you can submit your e-mail address. Your user name and password then will be e-mailed to you.

Changes to the Privacy Policy

CFNP may revise or amend this policy at any time at our sole discretion. If we make any substantive changes in the way we collect or use personally identifying information provided by users, we will post a prominent announcement on our web site home page and post the changes on this page. We will never change our policies and practices to make them less protective of user information collected prior to the effective date of any changes without the consent of affected users. We encourage users to visit this page periodically to review our current policy.
